remission of fees & student loans

The following groups of people qualify for remission of tuition fees and only pay a £20 registration fee.

- unemployed people in receipt of Jobseekers' Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance or receiving Universal Credit.
- students aged 19-23 years who are working towards their first full Level 3 qualification.

Evidence must be produced to show your eligibility.

Students over the age of 24 studying for Level 3 qualifications can apply for an Advanced Learning Loan to pay for their fees. Contact the College for further details.

Students aged 16-18 on 1st September 2015 do not pay any fees.

Students under the age of 16 are not eligible for concessions.
