- Friendship interactions that may be affecting your child;
- Information pertaining to their learning needs;
- Family circumstances affecting your child.

It is not appropriate to request particular teachers or write about teachers in these requests. I would hope that your child's teacher has been informed of any social support and learning support currently needed by your child in the course of the year. Information you provide is used in conjunction with the teacher's knowledge of each student to draft 2015 lists across the cohort of students. This is not an easy task and I'm sure you realise I cannot guarantee every request can be met. There are many factors that contribute to a child's learning, social development and happiness at school and their class placement is just one of them.

I invite you to write to me or email me at greg.walker@cg.catholic.edu.au with your considerations. You will receive a reply from me or one of the front office staff so you know your request has reached me. If you don't receive a reply, I do not have your request. **Considerations will close on Friday 17 October (Week 1 Term 4).**


