

ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAM GIVES THE PLANET THE BENEFIT OF THE DOUBT

Few would argue that environment has taken a back seat since the global financial crisis hit the world in late 2008. The implosion within the ranks of the Federal Liberal Party as it attempts to agree upon an emissions trading regime points to wider community confusion over climate change and what do about it. With the developing world now seeking a similar standard of living as that we enjoy here in Australia, the world is certainly heading for a major sustainability crisis.

It matters little what the climate change skeptics have to say about whether the globe is warming or not. The type of industrial explosion that is going on in China, India and many other so called poorer nations in South East Asia and South America means that the world is already heading for a natural resources crisis, not to mention major pollution problems in many cities around the globe.

A recent visit to South East Asia confirmed this and I can see little reason to change my long held belief that we must give the planet the benefit of the doubt and embrace sensible climate change reforms.

We all need to play our part. The argument that Australia only contributes around 1% of the world's green house gas emissions is not a valid excuse for doing nothing and future generations will certainly not thank us for this type of inertia.

Against this background, the motor industry in Western Australia has been working away to reduce its environmental impact through the Green Stamp Program which recently celebrated its 10th birthday. This innovative program was launched well before Al Gore pricked the world's conscience on climate change. It has very successfully engaged small and medium enterprises (SME's) within the motor industry to protect the environment through recycling, greater energy efficiency, reducing green house gas emissions and responsible waste disposal.

The key to success for Green Stamp has not been a heavy handed regulatory approach but the engagement of SME's in voluntary compliance through their industry association. This has led to the adoption of Green Stamp in all other States and Territories and by the printing and cleaning industries here in WA. The Green Stamp model is now also being considered for adoption by the European Union (EU).

By adopting a grass roots approach involving face to face delivery through an industry representative at the business site, Green Stamp has assisted many SME's to incorporate processes that have led to sustainable environmental practices.

In recognition of this work, State Government has recently agreed to a further 3 year funding arrangement for the Green Stamp Program. One of the redeeming features of the Program is that it does not impose a massive cost burden on participating businesses that can then derive some benefit by promoting their environmental credentials to potential customers.

It is all part in taking a responsible approach on environmental issues – something that many politicians in Canberra are still struggling to accept.
