


Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **40,749** and changed to **51,144** in 2000, representing a change of **26%**. The household count in 2004 was **57,254** and the household projection for 2009 is **64,733**, a change of **13%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **90,782** and in 2000 it was **111,527**, roughly a **23%** change. The population in 2004 was **123,113** and the projection for 2009 is **137,754** representing a change of **12%**.


In 2004, females represented **51.9**% of the population with a median age of **48.8** and males represented **48.1%** of the population with a median age of **44.3** years.


In 2004, the most prominent age group in this geography is **75** + years. The age group least represented in this geography is **15 to 19** years.


