Code of Conduct for Bus Transportation for the Boys & Girls Club

The Boys & Girls Club of London welcomes new participants and returning participants. To ensure a safe travel for all, please review with your son/daughter our Code of Conduct. Everyone must abide to the following rules; this service is a privilege to use.

As a participant involved in activities at the Boys & Girls Club of London:

- 1. I have permission from parent and/or guardian to ride the Boys & Girls Club bus.
- 2. I must conduct myself in a manner which reflects positively on my peers, the Boys & Girls Club and myself.
- 3. My safety and the safety of others, while on the bus, reflect on my actions.

In order to attend and continue to ride the Boys & Girls Club Bus, I will:

- 1. Have no physical contact or harassment with anyone;
- 2. Remain seated at all times. Once a seat has been chosen. I will not switch seats:
- 3. Always use appropriate language, No swearing or teasing to others;
- 4. Follow the instructions given by Boys & Girls Club staff members, the bus driver, the bus monitor or other community members in a respectful manner;
- 5. Be a positive role model for my peers at all times, especially on the bus:
- 6. Not consume food or drink on the bus.

If I break any of these rules, I understand the following consequences will happen:

Strike 1: Receive a Verbal warning of loss of bus privileges, and a call home.

Strike 2: Lose bus transportation for the following week. Parent is contacted.

Strike 3: Lose bus transportation for the remainder of the school year. Parent is contacted.
