- Days 1-4: November 2-5, 2016 Depart U.S./Mumbai
- Days 5-6: November 6-7, 2016 Mangalore/Coorg
- Days 7-8: November 8-9, 2016 Kabini
- **Days 9-10: November 10-11, 2016** Mysore
- Days 11-15: November 12-16, 2016 Bangalore/Houseboat Cruise/Kochi

Day 16: November 17, 2016 Depart for U.S.

- Arrive in Mumbai and visit Mani Bhawan, Mahatma Ghandi's headquarters from 1917-1934. Tour the acclaimed Prince of Wales museum, then embark on an excursion to Dharavi. Visit the Crawford Market, a huge Raj-era arcade.
- ➤ Fly to Mangalore, where you will travel to Coorg. Your stay will be on the Orange County Resort, a 300-acre working coffee and spice plantation. Back at the plantation, get a walking tour and learn about coffee grown here.
- ➤ Travel to Nagarhole National Park, one of India's finest preserves. Here, you have the chance to encounter the Bengal Tiger, Asian elephant, Indian bison, wild dog, deer, antelope, and hyena. Then, set out on a boat safari through some of Nagarhole's 247 square miles. Next, embark on a jeep safari in search of wildlife, returning to the lodge to see Orange County's Butterfly Park. In Gundathur, visit a local family in their home.
- ➤ This afternoon, travel to Mysore, stopping along the way to visit the river island town of Srirangapatna and its 9th-century Hindu Ringanatha Temple. Experience Mysore Palace lit up with more than 98,000 bulbs. Next, travel to the Chamundi Hills and visit the Palace of Mysore.
- ➤ Take an orientation tour of Bangalore, the "Silicon Valley" of India. Fly to Kochi, then begin your leisurely cruise of the Arabian Sea. Go ashore at local villages and farms. Return to Kochi and enjoy a walking tour of Fort Kochi, then attend a performance of Kathakali dance. Explore Kochi's Old Town on your own, then enjoy a sunset harbor cruise.
- ➤ Board an early morning flight for your return to the U.S.
