## DEACON JON

It is difficult to imagine God denying any of us entry into heaven through the narrow gate, and yet, in answer to someone asking the question, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Jesus answered saying, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter, but will not be strong enough."

Looking at the reading from Hebrews, we might think God is punishing us for our faults and failures but on the contrary, God is a wise and caring Father who desires only to make His children better. It is because God loves us too much to overlook our sins and selfish ways that He sends difficulties to train us in righteousness and to raise us to spiritual adulthood.

As a matter of fact, we are being forged in the image of God the Son, who "learned obedience through what He suffered." So, to the question; "Does God deny any of us entry into heaven?" We can say that salvation depends first on God's graces, then on our cooperation and obedience. Jesus expresses the difficulties of the spiritual life where few will enter God's glory while the door remains open.

Those of us who accept God's graces, listen with our hearts and follow where the Holy Spirit is guiding us, will certainly enter through the narrow gate. In human terms, it might be compared to running a marathon race or long distance bicycle ride. As the runner or cyclist gets closer to the finish line (narrow gate), fatigue sets in and it becomes difficult to imagine reaching the finish line. We want to be strong even to the end of the race if we are to get to the finish line. Often though, distractions get in our way. We get busy, too busy to pray. We get lazy or we'd prefer to watch our favorite TV programs rather than pray or read about our faith. We allow temptations to overrule our lives and where God wants us to be.

God is merciful and invites all of us to join Him from all corners of the earth. Will we allow the temptations and difficulties of life to cause us to fall short of the finish line, not be strong enough to enter through the narrow gate, or will we overcome them and be able to enter through the narrow gate? The decision is up to us.
