

Lift Up Your Hearts

I thank you all for your patience as our church lighting project continues. I know that it has been a long wait, but in the end, I believe that it will have been well worth it. You might have already noticed the addition of the 4 wall sconces in the main vestibule, which provides a much brighter and more welcoming entrance for our church. Thank you to all who have supported our ongoing Capital Campaign and this much anticipated project.

I would also like to acknowledge and thank Mrs. Antonietta Costa for her generous donation in memory of her husband, Joseph Costa, and her daughter, Rosalia "Lilly" Costa-Clarke, esq., to purchase and install lighting to illuminate the sanctuary Crucifix and statues of the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph. The new lighting fixtures will very fittingly and dramatically highlight these sacred images.

In my time here, many of you have spoken fondly of the spot light which once shone on the image of the Holy Spirit (the Dove), high above the altar. The placement of two new fixtures in a position where the lamps can more easily be replaced will enable us to fully appreciate this beautiful feature again. This is a more recent addition to the lighting plan and the cost for the light fixtures and labor is approximately \$5,000. If any parishioner would like to consider a donation in this amount to illuminate the Holy Spirit in memory of a loved one, please be sure to contact me at the rectory.

You may also notice the foundation being laid on the rectory front lawn near the church driveway. This is to prepare a place to relocate the beautiful life-size marble statue of the Sacred Heart which now stands on the corner of 54th and Carnegie Streets in Lawrenceville at the former St. Kieran Church. We can all appreciate how much this statue means to the people of St. Kieran, and later St. Matthew, parish over the years, and we are very happy to provide a new home for it on our church grounds. Again, there is some cost involved (about \$4,000) in the moving and placement of the statue. If anyone would like to make a donation toward this special project, please let us know.

Our congratulations and prayers go to Sister Judith Kenaan, csj, on her Golden Jubilee as a Sister of St Joseph. Many thanks for your service to the Lord and to the people of St. Raphael parish and school.
