Lee W. Livermore, BAA

Mr. Livermore is the Public Education Coordinator for the Upstate New York Poison Center. He has a bachelor’s degree in business and has several certifications in communication, training, organizational development and personality profile assessments. Lee is responsible for public education outreach in approximately 54 of the 62 counties in New York State. One of the Lee’s responsibilities is to develop partnerships and alliances with community agencies, task forces, and land granted organizations throughout the Poison Center’s coverage area, to help promote the utilization and awareness of the Poison Center’s services and educational programs. He is a highly sought after guest speaker and is known for his energetic presentations.
