You may begin to dismantle your booth no earlier than 4 p.m. Saturday, August 13, 2016. The bourse floor must be vacated by 7 p.m. Saturday. More information will be provided prior to the convention as to the hours and length of time for set-up.

REFUND POLICY: Should company/applicant cancel this contract for any reason, refunds shall be figured from the date designated as dealer move-in and according to the following schedule: More than 90 days prior to dealer move in, \$200 shall be retained by the ANA; less than 90 to 30 days prior, 50% of bourse fees shall be retained by the ANA; less than 30 days prior, 100% of bourse fees shall be retained by the ANA.

A security room will be available for all convention participants prior to set up.
