After the GFOAT Spring Institute, the Center for Public Management and GFOAT will sponsor a Public Funds Investment Act Workshop at the Renaissance Austin Hotel. The Public Funds Investment Act requires chief financial officers, treasurers, and investment officers of local governments to receive eight hours of investment training every two years. In addition, new investment officers are required to receive ten hours of training within the first 12 months after assuming their duties. A new two-year training cycle began on September 1, 2015.
