GENERAL INFORMATION

- Childers Festival The Childers Festival will operate over Saturday 30 July and Sunday 31 July in 2016. The festival commences in Crescent Street with only one stage, the Main Stage, operating on Saturday from 2pm to 10pm. The main Festival day is Sunday where there will be five stages in operation from 9am to 3.30pm. Generally speaking the crowd is considerably larger on Sunday than Saturday.
- Stages The three main stages in operation at the festival include the Main Stage and Stage Three which are suitable for bands and include back line, while Stage Two is a smaller stage which is suited to smaller acts such as duos and solo acts. Please note dedicated personnel will coordinate AV, sound and lighting at these stages for the duration of the festival. Both Stages Four and Five (indoor) have limited or no AV.
- 3. Entertainment Program In general, the festival will program a number of performers on each stage throughout the festival. Wherever possible, performers will be programed to use the same stage for all their acts. However this may not always be possible, particularly as only one stage is used on Saturday and five on Sunday.
- 4. Duration of Performances The Festival recognises that each performer and often each act may require different duration times for the performance. In general, the accepted times for bands is from 45 to 60 minutes, duos and solo performers from 30 to 45 minutes, and dancing acts generally form 15 to 30 minutes. Please note that this is a guide and the panel is prepared to consider duration of acts that fall outside these times.
- 5. Roving Performers Roving performers have traditionally been part of the festival, and are therefore welcome to complete the Performer EOI Application.
- 6. Water Water is provided for performers at each stage.
- 7. Smoking The Childers Festival is a Smoke-free event. However allowances have been made for smokers in designated areas outside the event area.
- 8. Pets Pets, with the exception of Guide Dogs for the blind are not allowed at the festival.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Selection of Groups All EOI's will be evaluated by a selection panel, on the following criteria:-
 - Suitability of act / performer with respect to the overall festival
 - Quality and type of performances / presentations
 - Participant details, group size and performance type
 - Previous inclusions and range of applications received
 - Budgetary considerations
- 2. Sound Checks Please be aware that sound check times will be advised directly by the respective AV company.
- 3. Dressing Room Two dressing rooms (3m x 3m marquees) will be provided for performers at two stages. This space is to be shared between all performers and therefore change times should be kept to a minimum and the dressing rooms remain tidy at all times. Please ensure that valuables are not left unattended in the marquees.
- 4. Alcohol and Drug Policy The performers shall not consume, use, be under the influence of or have in their possession or allow any member of its staff to consume, use or have in their possession, alcohol or illegal drugs anywhere within the Childers Festival event site.
- 5. First Aid Queensland Ambulance Service will be in attendance at the event to provide First Aid services. All accidents and incidents must be reported to a Council Events staff member or directly with QAS.
- 6. All performances are expected to be professional and not undertake any behaviour of acts that may be seen as offensive, including the use of live music using offensive language.
- 7. Weather In the event of wet weather during the Childers Festival, performers are required to continue operating at the event, providing it is safe to do so. The event may be cancelled and the event site closed by the Event Coordinator if the weather becomes dangerous and it is no longer safe to operate on the day.
- 8. Payment Performers are required to complete a Creditor Details Form to be eligible for payment. Performers will receive payment after the event.
- 9. APRA Performers must complete the APRA Statement of Musical Works Performed two weeks before the commencement of the festival. Please note the information collected is forwarded to APRA to ensure the respective songwriters can be properly recognized and remunerated for the material played at the festival.
- 10. Marketing and Promotion The performer/s give/s consent for Bundaberg Regional Council to use their details in the 2016 and future Childers Festival marketing and promotional campaigns.
- 11. Accommodation Accommodation only may be offered to artists who live outside the Bundaberg, Fraser Coast & North Burnett Council regions, particularly if they are playing both days of the festival.
- 12. Public Liability Insurance The Performer is required to ensure they have a minimum level of Public Liability cover of \$10 million, and provide a copy of their Public Liability Certificate of Currency if this EOI application is successful.
- 13. Cancellation Policy Bundaberg Regional Council reserves the right to cancel the event at any time.
