Reading logs are assigned and should be filled out each day as part of the homework. Students should read a minimum of 20 minutes everyday. This requirement can be completed by the child reading to the parent, the child silent reading, or occasionally the parent reading to the child. During or after the required reading, parents should always ask questions about what the child has read. This will help the child's reading comprehension. Students should complete the summary on the back of this page. The log will be checked on Friday to make sure the student has finished his/her required reading. Completion of the reading log will determine a portion of the reading grade on the report card. Reading logs should always be kept in the homework folder.

Read 20 minutes each night and fill out the reading log!

# Summary

A summary is a brief fact or statement about the book. The summary should be three to five sentences in length about one of the books your child read during the week. Make sure the summary is in your child's own words.
