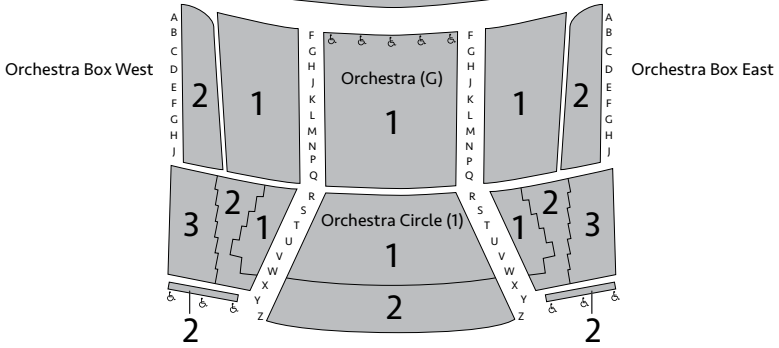
NORTHROP DANCE SEATING CHARTS

with price zones

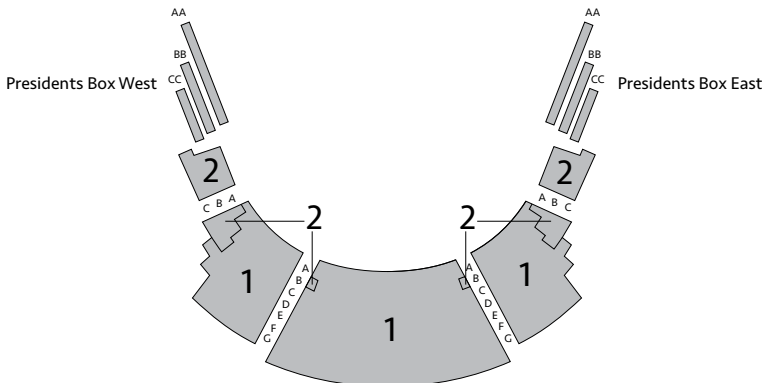

Ground Floor



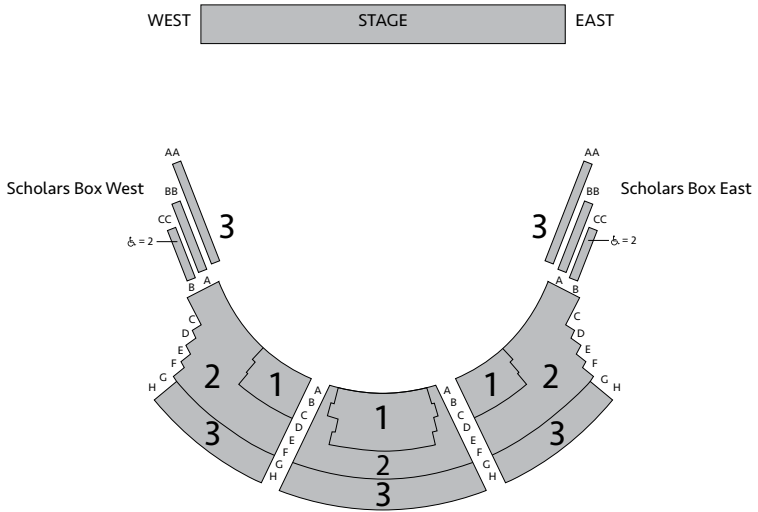
ORCHESTRA CIRCLE
First Floor



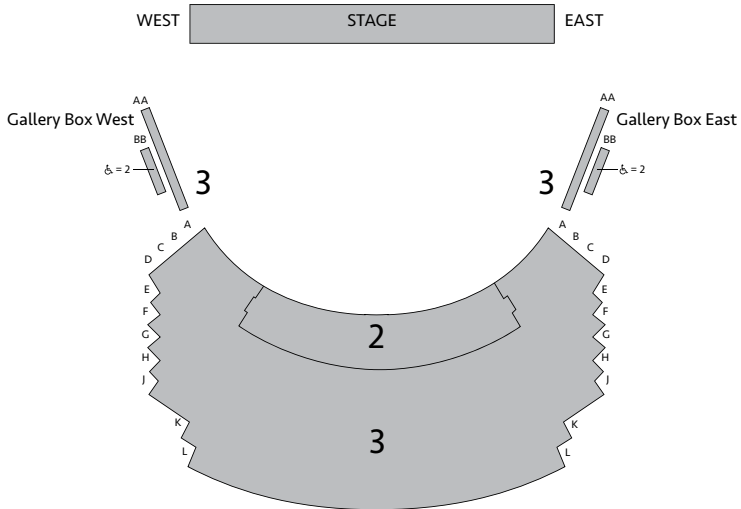
PRESIDENTS CIRCLE

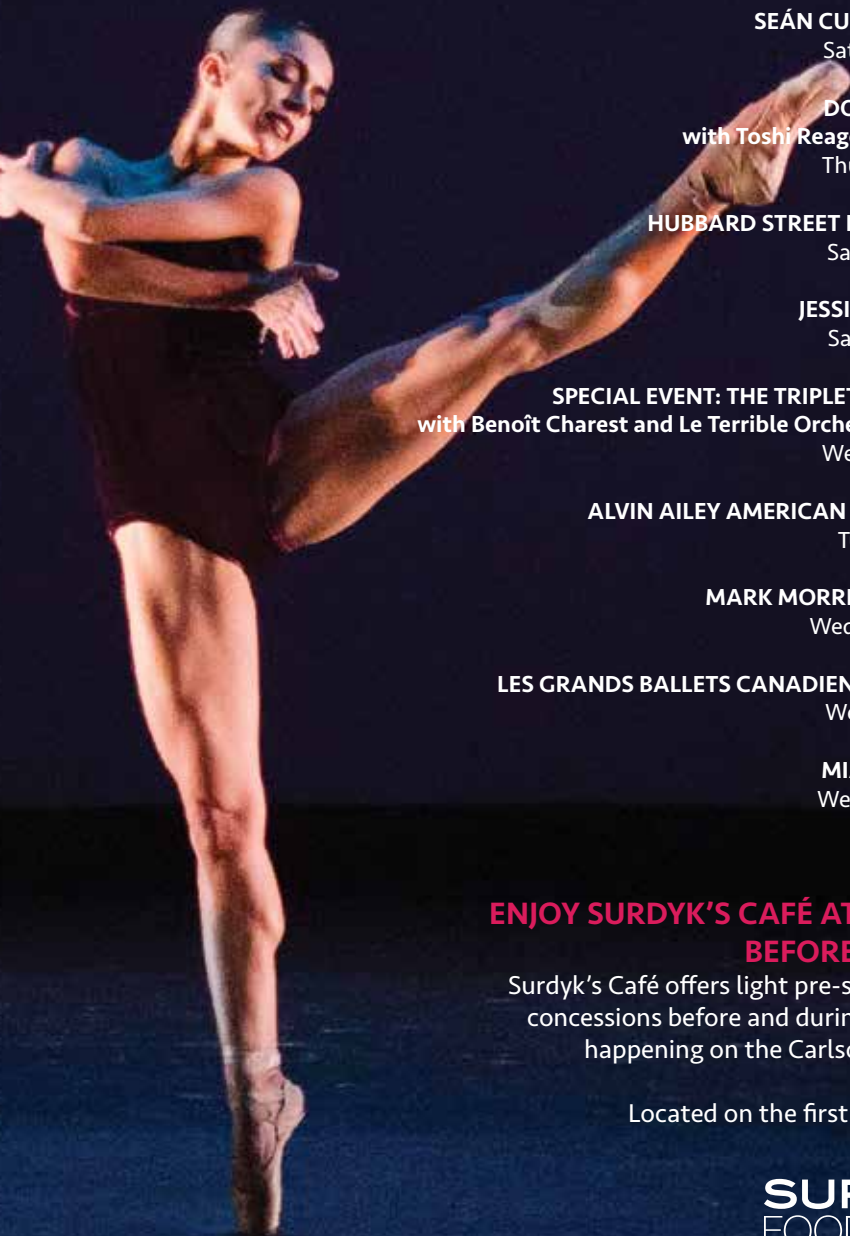

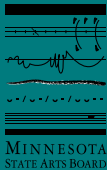

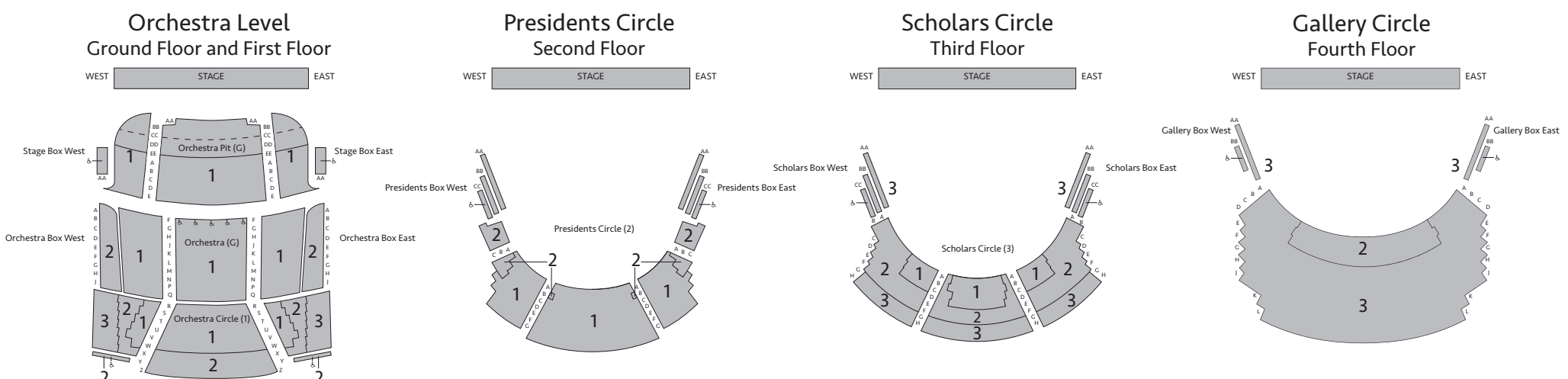
