T1. Effective Management – 10 things you need to know

Leadership is about making things happen, putting your stamp on the future. Research clearly indicates that leadership skills can be identified and developed through training. In today's busy management environment we sometimes need to stop and reflect on our own management techniques and ask is it working well for the credit union and is working well for myself.

This seminar aims to briefly explore ten important topics of general credit union management. Through a series of discussions, exercises and case studies, this action packed five hour management course presents a review of modern management techniques to hone your skills.

• This course is ideal for managers and senior employees.

T2. Risk Management and Fraud Awareness – defining and analysing fraud risk

Most frauds in a credit union are discovered by accident. Your credit union needs to adopt a practical approach to introducing measures to determine the levels of internal risk of fraud and where fraud is suspected to be able to quantify and qualify suspicions.

Presented by an experienced credit union practitioner, participants will explore key internal controls and use practical examples and experiences to create an action plan to take back to the credit union for reducing the risk of fraud.

• This course is ideal for managers, directors, supervisors and individuals responsible for risk management.

T3. Financial Controls in the Credit Union – essential accounting controls

How important are financial controls in the credit union? What are the essential accounting controls? Financial control is important in any business and credit unions are no exception.

This seminar will explore the implementation of effective financial controls and practices in the credit union. Participants will look at the credit union accounting cycle and the details of financial controls.

• This course is ideal for managers, treasurers and employees responsible for the finance functions in the credit union.

T4. Staff development and appraisals

The most important resource in your credit union is your people. Giving proper and effective support and offering the right development will benefit not only them as individuals but would enable them to achieve their potential and contribute to the provision of excellent service to your members.

This workshop would provide guidance, hints and tips on understanding and identifying development needs, appraisal and developing and coaching people.

• This course is ideal for managers and team leaders.

T5. Lending in a Competitive Environment

Have you ever looked at what the rest of the lending market is doing? Competitor analysis is an essential part of lending practice and helps you to understand what you members want from a lending product.

With the aid of an experienced trainer you will explore the current lending market in the UK and explore the issues and trends that affect the market. Aligning this knowledge with credit union lending ethos and practice the course will look at what the needs of your members are, who else meets those needs and explore the competitive advantage of credit unions.
