Arts Funding Grant Agreement

2. Use the funds during the 2015-2016 school year.
3. Acknowledge the gift from both **Far West Recycling and Young Audiences** on your website and/or in your newsletter, and at performances (if applicable).
4. Provide an opportunity for Far West Recycling and/or Young Audiences staff to visit during implementation of the project.
5. Submit a brief final report to Young Audiences (hard copy or via email) that outlines how you used the funds, how many children participated, and how it benefitted your students and/or school. Please include **pictures** and/or **videos** of implementation. Photos may be used in our final report to Far West Recycling, on social media, and printed materials.

If you do not fulfill any of these requirements you may forfeit the current funds and/or future funding.
