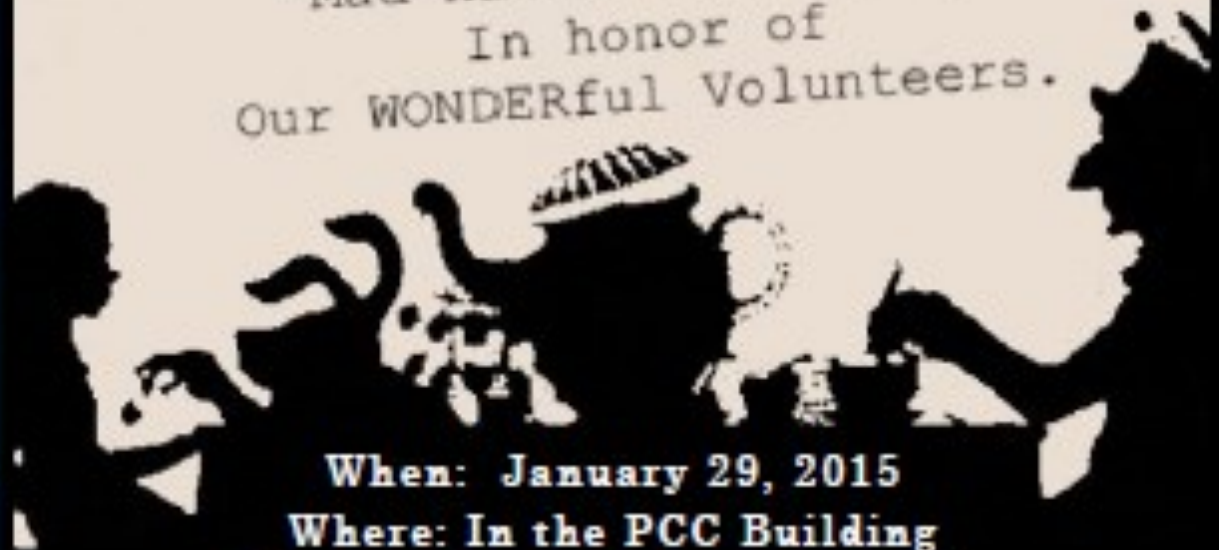

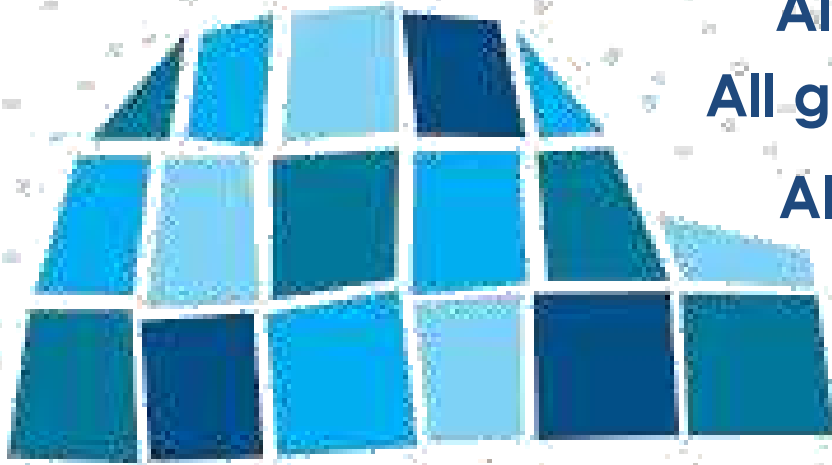

2. Auditions will be held on Wednesday, January 21 and Thursday, January 22 in the Music room and/or room 216 (if we go past 4:30pm). Auditions are closed to spectators (parents, friends, etc.) They may wait in the hallway with you, but may not enter the room during your audition. 3. All students in grades 6 – 8 are invited to try-out for the Talent Show. Each performer or group MUST audition in order to perform in the show. We will limit the number of acts to 20 for the show.
