

Dear Friends at the Food Shelves and Pantries across Southwestern Minnesota,

We thank God for you and for the work you, your staff and volunteers do to provide healthy, nutritious food at no cost to the estimated 76,300 hungry people in our part of the state.

During the month of March, many individuals and congregations from the Southwestern Minnesota Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) participated in the Minnesota Food Share campaign. We hope our donations of non-perishable food and cash helped stock your shelves so that this important work can continue.

Now, we want to do more. On June 12, 2015, we are planning to host a food packing event in St. Peter. We are partnering with Outreach, Inc., an organization based in Union, Iowa, which has extensive experience in packing meals for domestic (i.e. United States) distribution. Volunteers from our synod will be packing two types of meals: (1) macaroni and cheese and (2) red beans and rice. The meals are packed in 3-ply plastic bags, vacuum-sealed, and stamped with lot numbers and expiration dates. The bags are then packed in cardboard boxes, with each box holding 36 bags or 216 meals. Each box weighs 33 pounds and is 10 x 12 x 14 inches in dimension. We expect to package between 83,000-100,000 meals in the four hour event (380-465 boxes). These meals have an indefinite shelf life, but retain maximum nutritional value when used within two years. When cooked with the appropriate amount of water, each bag contains six servings of good tasting, vitamin enriched food. Meals are microwavable.

Of course, all this is great and wonderful, but our labor is in vain if we cannot get these meals to the people who really need them. This is where you come in! We would like to share some of these meals with every food shelf or pantry in our synod (at no cost) so that they can be distributed to the hungry. In order for volunteers to bring them to your doorstep between June 14 and June 18, we will need the following information from you:
