## **Carols Around The Christmas Tree**


## Tuesday, December 21st, 6 - 7.30pm. Methwold Village Hall

### Cetti, Cetti bang bang!

One of the most frustrating things about birdwatching is that with a lot of species of birds, you can hear them, but despite your best efforts, you can't see them! The bird that I will be writing about this month certainly fits this stereotype; it is the Cetti's warbler; (pronounced chetti's) a wetland dwelling bird with a lot of character.

You probably haven't heard of this bird, but if you go to a place where it lives at the right time of year, you will almost certainly hear it, even if you don't know what it is. "Cetti's", as they are known probably have the loudest song of any British bird.

This song has been described in many ways. The best mnemonic I have heard is: "Me, Cetti? If you don't like it, shove off!" This neatly describes the attitude with which this song is usually delivered, loud and in your face.

You would have thought that with a song this loud and obvious, these birds would be pretty easy to see. However, they are notorious skulkers, and usually deliver their song unseen from thick cover. If you do manage to catch a glimpse of one, it looks like a large wren, with warm brown upper parts and a habit of cocking it's tail when it is nervous.

You may wonder where they get their name from. They are named after Francesco Cetti, an eighteenth century Italian Jesuit priest and zoologist, who first identified this species in his native Sardinia. They were confined to continental Europe until the early 1960s when the British invasion began......

The first British record was in 1961, in Hampshire. They bred for the first time on our shores in 1971 at Stodmarsh in Kent. Since then, they have colonised most of southern Britain. At the turn of the millennium, there were around 700 pairs, with 143 pairs in Norfolk alone! Ten years down the line, there are now over 1000 pairs in Britain!

They have even spread to Lakenheath Fen. They were first recorded on the reserve in 2004, and first nested in 2007. There are now at least four "shouting" males present, and they certainly add a lot of noise to the dawn chorus during spring and summer! I hope you have a peaceful and enjoyable festive season.



### Safer Neighbourhood & Home Watch Project

Reading through the statistics on the Norfolk SNT website I came across a statement that said Norfolk has one of the lowest crime rates in the UK. Well that might be true but it is hard to believe after the spate of crimes we have suffered in the parish in the last few weeks. Which is really the key point, we all know about the events that have affected our little part of the country and it is not to hard to feel that crime has gone up - in a sense it has; but only emotionally not statistically. It's a bit like lightening striking twice the odds against are high but when it happens it's very hard not to feel much more vulnerable. Consequently it is the fear of crime that creates the greatest effect and why it is important for neighbours to look out for each other to help restore confidence. A week or so ago I received a telephone call from one of our older residents who wanted to talk about the bogus caller who had turned up pretending to be a sales person from a double glazing manufacturer. Fortunately the would be con-man did not fool anyone. The caller had no appointment and their attitude left a lot to be desired for a sales person trying to get an order, rude, aggressive and clearly not trying to impress. In other words the image did not fit the story and so gave the lie to their motives. True not all con-men are so easy to spot and they can be very cleaver but they are not telling the truth and we can all spot that if we are looking for it.

Trust your instincts, if it feels wrong in any way even in the slightest degree or the caller is unexpected or you do not like the caller's attitude for some reason you can't quite put your finger on don't trust them. Any legitimate caller will either have an appointment made in advance or they will have identity and be very happy to show it clearly, directly and in a way that can easily be checked. Be aware that these people are willing to take advantage of your good nature; they know that most people are reluctant to cause offence or be distrustful. Rogue callers exist in other forms, for example, that of the "something for nothing" approach. Trading Standards have received information regarding a company telephoning residents in Northamptonshire offering free home security checks (playing on the fear of crime). If an appointment is a greed the security check will take two hours and will be primarily a sales pitch for a security system with the sales person being very persistent. Those residents who do require goods or services are advised to ask family or friends for recommendations and obtain at least three written quotes to compare the cost of the work before committing to anything.

With the advent of the "era of austerity" it is reasonable to assume that doorstep crime is likely to increase and we would all benefit from advanced warning of any criminal activity in our area. That is why the Home Watch system through the website and by other means is offering residents the chance to register and receive regular information about trends and the latest scams. This is very

useful information and will enable householders to prepare themselves against doorstep criminals.



## WHAT DOES THE DOCTOR THINK THIS MONTH? December 2010.

KIDS' TECHNOLOGY - The intransigent pushchair and its mates, the kiddie car seats!

When our kids were small, they rode up and down the length of the country in what were effectively cardboard boxes, bundled into the car between all the luggage. The oblong body of the pushchair was either placed in the oblong metal frame on four wheels or lifted out of the frame and stashed somewhere in the car. Calum once travelled from Birkenhead to Sussex, lying in his "box" on top of a chest of drawers, his nose only inches from the roof of the car. When a child became old enough, he graduated to a car seat. Ours was a square of canvas attached to a couple of metal hooks which hooked over the rear of the bench car seat. There were no restraining straps but the seat, when carried into the lunchtime café, doubled as a high chair when hooked over the back of a wooden chair. Once again, our kids travelled thousands of miles in this precarious arrangement, happily without incident. Later, when we had estate cars, it was not unusual to carry four kids in the back seat with another three sitting in the rear of the vehicle. These days, such behaviour would be totally unacceptable and, of course, extremely dangerous. The kids would be at risk and there would be so many exploding social workers vapourising by the roadside that they would become an endangered species (mmm).

How times have changed was demonstrated forcefully to Management and me when, last weekend, we travelled to look after Oliver (Grandchild aged 3, about whom you have read before) and his twin brothers, aged eighteen months, who are genetically programmed to go in opposite directions at any opportunity. Son and daughter-in-law welcomed us enthusiastically, handed us three car seats and a twin pushchair and pushed off for their long weekend at a wedding on the South coast. Head Office took the children indoors and I thought I would pop the car seats into my Renault Espace and put the folded pushchair in the boot. Well!!! The three car seats were different makes and none carried instructions. None of the seats was "Isofix" but it was obvious that each had to be placed on the car seat and fixed using the car seat belts. Each car seat belt had to wind in and out of the child seat, under tensioners, behind red plastic clips and so forth, before being clicked into its socket, after which the tensioners were put under tension and, with mighty heaving and feeding of the seat belt through a variety of slots, the child seat would be safely affixed to the car seat. And we haven't even started on the child belt buckle yet! A long, long time passed and, eventually, I managed to fix the child seats securely and I even managed to work out the seat buckles. (We once missed a train at Ely because, using a borrowed car seat to transport a grandchild, it took us nearly an hour to work out how to strap her in).



### Hospital Happenings December 2010 Monthly Ramblings about West Suffolk Hospital

#### Leaflets:

Just for information, the hospital produces various information leaflets about services and treatments not only in English but also in Russian, Chinese, Turkish, Polish and Portuguese amongst others. Leaflets may be downloaded from the hospital website or by telephone for printed copies.

#### **Home From Home Birthing:**

A new unit offering mothers the chance to give birth in a "home from home" has opened at the Hospital. The £470,000 midwifery-led birthing unit (MLBU) opened on 1st November, and welcomed its first baby at 10.08am.

The MLBU has been designed to provide mothers with a comfortable and "homely" environment in which to give birth. Colour, soft furnishings, music, pictures and soft lighting have all been used in the four individual rooms, while visible medical equipment has been kept to a minimum.

Various items to aid normal delivery, such as birthing balls and floor mattresses, are available in the unit, along with aromatherapy and massage. Emergency medical equipment is also easily accessible in case of any complications; while the hospital's wider medical team can also give extra support if necessary. The unit has been specially designed to be as relaxing and calming as possible, providing a safe, sensitive and supportive environment in which to give birth. We hope that the number of women who need medical interventions will be reduced as a result, in turn ensuring as many as possible can enjoy a normal labour and birth. It is suitable for women who need midwifery care only, whilst those with more complex needs will continue to receive specialist individualised care from the obstetrics team.

The MLBU has been co-located with the central delivery suite, so that any women who develop complications can be quickly transferred into the care of a consultant.

#### Case of the Month:

This month I was informed of a case with a successful outcome against the odds. Apparently a local woman phoned 999 to say her husband had stopped breathing and could she have an ambulance please. The nearest ambulance was not likely to get to her rural location immediately and so she was asked if she had any cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) skills. Upon the answer, "No, none" the call was transferred to paramedics who guided the woman through the whole procedure over her speaker phone. She carried out CPR for some 15 minutes until the ambulance arrived and the team took over. To my surprise and delight


