Studying either language will prepare you for a high school language course, and many students find it rewarding to explore one language here and another in high school.

We encourage students to see this time as an exploration of a world language, as well as a time to decipher how to learn a new language.

Scheduling can be complicated and we appreciate as much flexibility as possible when placing students. We do our best to accommodate students, but we cannot guarantee placement in your preferred choice for two reasons:

- •Students are assigned to academic groups according to several considerations including Math placement and scheduling issues related to individual educational needs.
- •Due to the small size of our World Language faculty, we will be assigning students evenly between the two languages.
