# 1) Questions/ Answers.

- a. Are manhole coatings required as indicated on page 74 of the Upper Thompson Sanitation District Rules and Regulations? *Yes*
- b. Is tracer wire required as indicated on UTSD detail 2240 and 2220A? Yes
- c. Based on discussion at the prebid, is it a correct assumption that the district will perform all required testing of the pipe and manholes? Yes, Upper Thompson Sanitation District will perform all required testing.
- d. Who will handle the compaction testing? No compaction testing will be required. The project will be under a two year warranty, so any excessive settlement will be repaired as warranty work.
- e. <u>Can you confirm that excess spoils, trees and/or boulders will be left onsite?</u>

  Cheley Camps will provide a location for onsite disposal of excess spoils, trees, stumps and or boulders.
- f. The Ductile Iron sewer called out as class 51 or 53, will there be any lining requirements on the interior? All Ductile Iron Pipe Sewer Main lining is to be Protecto 401, Ceramic Epoxy.
- 2) All work is to be incompliance with the "Upper Thompson Sanitation Rules & Regulations, Amended January 2015". Including but not limited to "Appendix C, Waste Water Collection System Specifications" and "Appendix I, Standard Details". The Rules and regulations can be down loaded at:

3) Contractor should take note of Note 13, Detail 2610, of Appendix I Standard Details: "Install concrete collar flush with rim on all new manholes. Extend to a minimum of 6-inches below top of cone section. Minimum of 6-inch width for full circumference. Collar not required on rings or covers located in in asphalt and /or concrete".

## **DIVISION 1**

## SECTION 01025 - MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT (Revised January 5, 2016)

#### **PART 1 - GENERAL**

The entire cost of the work and the material necessary to complete all items shown or implied on the Drawings or specified herein shall be included and merged into the pay items shown in Section 00310, Proposal Schedules. All payments shall be subject to the conditions of these specifications.

All pay items shall include materials, transportation expenses to the job site, cost of installation and maintenance during construction, guarantees and warranties, if applicable, profit, sales tax, license, permits, and other taxes required for the completion of the project in place for each item in the bid schedules.

No additional compensation will be allowed for any item completed beyond the limits as shown on the Contract Drawings without the prior written approval of the Engineer.

## **PART 2 - MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT**

#### Item 1 - Mobilization

This item shall be paid on a lump sum basis and shall include moving onto the site of all equipment and materials; providing a construction trailer and sanitary facilities at the site and installation of other construction facilities as required by the specifications.

#### Item 2 - 8" SDR 35 Sewer Main.

This item shall be paid on a linear foot basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the installation including but not limited to the following: tree removal, bedding, excavation, dewatering, bedding, pipe (8" SDR 35), fittings, backfill, compaction, utility locates, testing and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 2A - 10" Ductile Iron Pipe. (Revised January 5, 2016)

This item shall be paid on a linear foot basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the installation including but not limited to the following: tree removal, bedding, excavation, dewatering, bedding, pipe (10" Ductile Iron Pipe STA 1+00 to STA 1+39), fittings, backfill, compaction, utility locates, testing and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 3 – Manhole Connection (STA-1+00) (Revised January 5, 2016)

This item shall be paid on a per item basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the connection of the new sewer main to the existing manhole located in Rockwood Lane including but not limited to the following: traffic control, right of way permit, excavation, bedding, fittings, connection of DIP pipe, concrete encasement, grouting, insulation, backfill, compaction, road repair and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 4 - Standard Manhole

This item shall be paid on a per item basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the manhole installation including but not limited to the following:

excavation, dewatering, bedding, precast manhole, rim, lid, ladder, connection to sewer main, fittings, backfill, compaction and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 5 - Drop Manhole

This item shall be paid on a per item basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the drop manhole installation including but not limited to the following: excavation, dewatering, bedding, precast manhole, rim, lid, ladder, connection to sewer main including existing, fittings, backfill, compaction and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 6 - Stream Crossing (~STA 11+55)

This item shall be paid on a per item basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the installation including but not limited to the following: excavation, cofferdams, dewatering, Class 52 DIP Pipe, concrete encasement w/ reinforcement, fittings, bedding, backfill, compaction, testing and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 7 Stream Crossing (~STA 27+25)

This item shall be paid on a per item basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the installation including but not limited to the following: excavation, cofferdams, dewatering, Class 52 DIP Pipe, concrete encasement w/ reinforcement, fittings, bedding, backfill, compaction, testing and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

### Item 8 - Blasting

This item shall be paid on a linear foot basis when trench excavation cannot be accomplished using a Caterpillar 320 excavator with a ripper tooth or comparable size machine with a ripper tooth and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide required blasting to facilitate the installation of a of the sewer main and manholes including but not limited to the following: drilling, loading, blasting, excavation and all appurtenances either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to provide a complete and functional facility.

## Item 9 - Clay Barriers

This item shall be paid on a per each basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the installation of the clay barriers including but not limited to the following: excavation, clay material, placement, compaction and all items either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to complete the site.

#### Item 10 - Erosion Control

This item shall be paid on a lump sum basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to preform measures required to control erosion and sedimentation and water pollution including but not limited to the following: CDPH Stormwater Discharge Permit Associated w/ Construction, straw erosion bales, stakes, silt fence, check dams, trash removal, tracking pads, concrete washout structure and all items either shown or implied in the Contract Documents or determined in the Stormwater Discharge Permit for proper execution of the work.

# Item 11 - Re-vegetation

This item shall be paid on a lump sum basis and shall include all of the costs for labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the re-vegetation work including but not limited to the following: top soil, fine grading, seeding, mulching, landscaping, and all items either shown or implied in the Contract Documents to complete the site.
