(Subject Pronoun)

**Whom**  
(Direct Object Pronoun)

➤ ***Whom** shall we ask to the party?*

Whose  
(Possessive Pronoun)

Used to find out which person something \_\_\_\_\_ to.

➤ ***Whose** camera is this?*

That  
(Specific/ \_\_\_\_\_ Clause)

Used with restrictive clause (refers to something \_\_\_\_\_ **and** \_\_\_\_\_ **a subject**)

➤ *She wanted to buy a scarf **that** would complement her blue eyes.*

Which  
(General/ \_\_\_\_\_ Clause)

Used with a non-restrictive clause (does not refer to something \_\_\_\_\_)

Oftentimes contains a \_\_\_\_\_

➤ *The answers, **which** you can find in the back of the book, are sometimes incorrect.*
