Our Children's Ministry Team encourages all children to make a difference in this world, this community, and in this church. Mission Education is very important and in Isaiah 6:8 it states: "Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me." We teach your children that they are "on mission" right now. We give kids hands-on opportunities for missions and allow them to be messengers for Christ. Missions education is a part of the Christian education process just as elementary schools have career days to help children understand where their talents and abilities fit in. Missions education is just another way to show kids where they might be used. In the past, children have prayed for others, bought cows and sheep and other animals thru the Heifer Project, raised money for the orphanage in India, for Mercy Ship for doctors to help children. for water wells in Africa, clothes for Back to School Program, FAITH bags, as well as sending children with cancer and their parents on a weekend retreat right here in Destin. We currently have children praying for others, bringing in school supplies for local schools, bringing in clothes for Back to School Bash, collecting money for Juvenile Diabetes, participating in the FAITH bags and supporting a Bus Ministry for ten kids and four youth kids. So, please discuss with children what it means to be "on mission" for God at home, at school, in their community, in their country, and throughout the world.
