Def: A procedure where a dye is injected into a vein in the arm so that an x-ray can be preformed. Abbrev. IVP

**tcshe** X-Ray C H E S T  
Def: Radiographic assessment of the pulmonary and cardiac systems. Abbrev. CXR

**oltdnruaus** U L T R A S O U N D 2  
Def: A procedure used to visualize an internal body structure, or developing fetus. Abbrev. US

**uerl** Out R U L E 6  
Def: The wrong solution. Abbrev. R/O

**titnrntemtei** Positive Pressure Breathing I N T E R M I T T E N T  
Def: Controlled mechanical ventilation. Abbrev. IPPB

Turn, **hogcu**, Deep Breath C O U G H 3  
Def: Used to prevent complications of bed rest when patient is immobile esp. postoperatively. Abbrev. TCDB

**lvbrea** Order V E R B A L  
Def: Unwritten instructions given by a Nurse or Doctor. Abbrev. VO

**loylar** O R A L L Y 5  
Def: Given by mouth. Abbrev. PO

Normal **nseila** S A L I N E  
Def: Used to cleanse, irrigate, or moisturize wounds. Abbrev. N/S
