SUMMER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Registration will begin on April 16 at 9am online at <http://activenet.active.com/minneapolisparcs>.
- Registration is required for all programs, field trips, including free activities.
- Participants are not considered registered until all fees have been paid and participant receives a confirmation of registration.
- We reserve the right to reschedule classes due to weather or instructor/facility availability.
- When class minimum is not reached, we reserve the right to either postpone the beginning of the program or cancel it.
- Minneapolis residents who can not afford instructional fees because of economic need may apply for a fee waiver. Please contact the park director at your local recreation center for more information.
- All programs will list Minneapolis resident cost for each of the programs. If you are **not** a Minneapolis resident you must pay an additional 50% on top of the Minneapolis resident cost.
- **NEW** A cancellation fee of \$5 will be charged for all activity refunds.

SPORTS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- A copy of participants birth certificate and payment are **required** at time of registration otherwise forms will not be accepted.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for transportation to and from all practices and games.
- **No refunds** will be issued after the first game is played.
- All equipment must be returned at the end of the season.

ACTIVEPASS PROGRAM

The Camden Community Parks has begun rolling out the next phase with the ActiveNet registration software. The next phase is called ActivePass. An ActivePass is similar to KidTrax ID's. Many of you have probably seen the form, filled it out but maybe are unsure what it is for. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. Here is some additional information regarding ActivePass.

What is ActivePass?

It is a pass designed to check people into programs.

What programs will the ActivePass be used for?

An ActivePass will be utilized for continuous programs, drop ins and extended hours. Examples of programming in which an ActivePass is needed are: senior card clubs, card tournaments, computer lab, open swimming, open gym, extended hours etc.

How do I sign my child up?

ActivePass registration forms can be picked up at your local recreation center. Fill out the form and turn it in to park staff. For your convenience, the ActivePass registration form is located in this brochure. Park staff will then enter your information into the database, take a picture and make an ActivePass for you to use in the future.

Can I sign them up online?

No, currently the only way to register is by stopping in a recreation center, filling out the form and to have staff input the data to produce an ActivePass.

Are these ActivePasses required?

These passes are a requirement to participate in all ActivePass programs. If someone does not have a card they will not be allowed to participate until they receive an ActivePass. Upon entering the recreation centers stop in at the front desk to check in.

Does the ActivePass expire?

The ActivePass does not expire but the picture should be updated on file every 3 to 4 years.

How do I get a replacement card?

Talk with park staff and they will reissue a card. The fee for a replacement card is \$1.

Why are we doing this?

We are using ActivePass to collect data, record usage and see who is using are building and at what times of the day.
