- Request for information from the advisory councils
 - How is a youth in crisis helped in your community? (who do you call, what happens next)
 - If a youth is already seeing a counselor (as most youth involved with DFS are) the counselor
 - If a crisis takes place at school, the school resource officer may be called
 - Other times parents may call the police, who then transfer to WBI or the Wyoming Medical Center (which may then transfer to WBI)
 - How would you like your feedback and views represented to a statewide task force?
 - Surveys would be best for this group of attendees- due to this being a busier time of year and preparation for federal reviews

 - o Question who the wraparound providers are in the area?
 - You can find a list of all providers on the Magellan of Wyoming website using the provider search tool. You can narrow by zip code and mile radius.
 - Comment about the domestic violence prevention services in Casper (The Self Help Center) which may be responsible for the lower numbers of DV arrests in Casper vs. Cheyenne. There are also



dedicated victims advocates who respond when called out. DFS has also been involved in interviewing kids who witness abuse (Preventive Assessment.)
