WESTOVER HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- 1. Rotating Medical Science and Allied Health students will be expected to possess the following clinical skills:
 - a. Bathing patients.
 - b. Vital signs: T.P.R. and B.P.
 - c. Bed-making, occupied and unoccupied.
 - d. Intake and output measurement.
 - e. Hot and cold applications.
 - f. Ambulating patients.
 - g. Transfer of patients via wheelchairs.
 - h. Delivery of properly packaged specimens to the laboratory.
 - i. Terminal cleaning of patient unit.
 - j. Feeding patients and passing trays.
 - k. Distributing nourishments, special diets.
 - 1. Back care and back massage for non-ambulatory patients.
 - m. Draping and positioning patients for examination; will not chaperone.
- 1. Under direct supervision from the staff and/or instructor they may observe any procedure that has the permission of the doctor and patient
- 2. At a minimum, orientation will include HIPPA and infection control training before patient care is initiated. The students will be prepared with Basic Life Support.
