# Hillside CSA Program 2015



The goal of Community Supported Agriculture **(CSA)** is to have its local community support the agricultural process. Members of the community get involved buy purchasing a share of the produce grown by the farmer, which helps reduce the cost of seeds, soil and other supplies. In return, participants receive fresh, local, and sustainably grown produce at a reduced price in comparison to supermarkets.

### What can you expect from Hillside's CSA?

- -You will see in your share several varieties of beans, beets, broccoli, cabbage, eggplant, lettuce, melon, sweet potatoes, peppers, tomatoes, and many other vegetables.
- -You have the opportunity to pick your own herbs: basil, chamomile, cilantro, oregano, parsley, sage, thyme, etc.
- -Members will periodically receive value added items: farm fresh eggs, honey, pesto, dressings, tea and herb infused cheeses.
  - -In addition you will receive a bouquet of cut flowers each week.

#### What is the cost of a share?

An 18-week harvest season starting June 23<sup>rd</sup> through October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Scheduled pick-up times will be Tuesday or Fridays from 3pm-6pm. The cost of a membership is \$260~share and \$495~family share. There is a \$200 non-refundable deposit due with the application submission and full payment is due on or before June 23, 2015.

#### How can I save on the cost of membership?

Shareholders of the Hillside CSA are encouraged to become part of the farm and garden. For those who volunteer **at least 7 hours** of their time will receive a \$50.00 refund. Stay a whole day or spread it over a few days; the choice is yours. Kids are welcome to help out and meet the farm animals too!
