2016 Term 1 Middle Years' Surf Programme

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

From the end of Week 5 Term 1, Outdoor Education is offering a Year 8/9 Learn to Surf (or surf better) Camp in Lancelin on March 4, 5 and 6.

Students will be staying at the Windsurfer Beach Chalets in dorm style accommodation. Surf lessons will run from local beaches and will take into consideration the weather conditions on the day. Transport to and from Lancelin and surf locations will be via College bus, which is fitted with seat belts.

There are 20 spaces in the programme and if, by popular demand, the programme is over subscribed participants will be selected by ballot. If we are under-subscribed, we may have to cancel the programme.

No previous experience is necessary, however if girls are looking to further develop their skills qualified surf coaches will be able to provide some training. We will be using soft-top boards and the sessions will be run by the MLC Outdoor Education staff.

This is an opportunity for your daughter to learn more about surfing and ocean safety. In addition, students will be preparing all their own meals and helping with the day to day running of the camp (i.e.: morning surf checks, setting up sun shelters and filling large water containers for the day).

The cost for the programme is approximately \$250 all-inclusive (food, accommodation and transport).

We will leave from the Hadley Hall car park at 7.30am on Friday 4 March and return to the College on the Monday 7 March by 1pm.

WHAT TO WEAR

For all the Outdoor Education activities and in particular the wet activities we ask that students wear bathers, board shorts, a broad brimmed hat and a sun smart top. No singlets please. Wet suits are not provided but if you have your own please bring it along.

THE PAPERWORK

Attached to this letter is a Sign Up Slip. We have 20 places available for the weekend so if your daughter would like to participate, please complete the Learn to Surf Sign Up Slip.

A medical, and payment slip will follow once students are confirmed. The paperwork will need to be completed and returned to Middle Years' Reception by Monday 22 February 2016.
