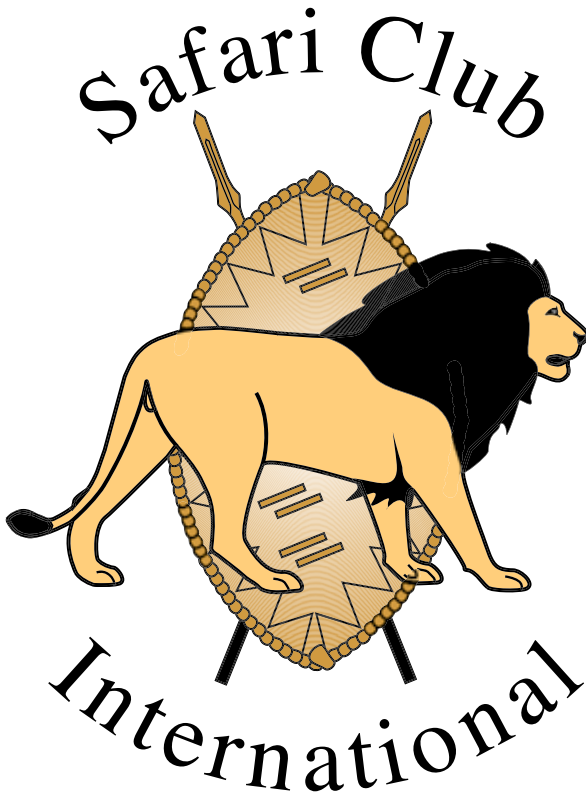

Auction Guidelines

Please read the item descriptions carefully. Different hunts include or specify different things, such as lodging, meals, transportation, weapon type, available dates, etc. As a general rule, hunting licenses are not included. On Canadian hunts, there may be P.S.T. and G.S.T. tax added to the selling price of a donated hunt.

The final bid on any item will be at the call of the auctioneer. Please don't lose an item that you want because of being shy. Make sure that the auctioneer or a spotter spot and acknowledge your bid. Wave your hands, yell, jump up and down, whatever you need to do. Once an item is sold, it's sold.

Some items have a minimum bid required. If the final bid is below the minimum, the high bidder has the option of buying the item at the minimum price. If they decline, anyone may purchase the item at the minimum price from the auctioneer or cashier on a first come, first served basis.

Purchasers of trips need to contact the donor within 30 days to schedule the dates.

While it is not required with every hunt, we encourage you to upgrade your hunt. Taking additional animals, days, or additional hunters on the trip helps to support those that support us. Many times these additions are at a discount. Talk with your outfitter, and have an enjoyable trip.

We do our best to solicit only from competent outfitters, but we can not guarantee the quality or success of any hunts purchased at our auction. If you buy a hunt at our auction that the donor fails to provide for you, through no fault of your own, we will make arrangements for a replacement hunt or will issue you a credit to be used by the next two fundraisers. If you simply find it inconvenient to go on the dates available, or change your mind for any reason, it is to be worked out between you and the outfitter.

We encourage you to submit pictures and stories of your purchased trips for inclusion in the newsletter. We love to hear the tales, and you might win a Cabela's gift certificate.

All firearms purchased or won can not be taken with the owner. Firearms must be picked up at Total Firearms-1380 N Cedar, Mason (517) 699-0597 starting on Sunday. Call for hours.

Located adjacent to Granite Creek in the Gros Ventre Wilderness Area, within the Bridger-Teton National Forest, this package includes a cabin for 3 nights and includes 9 meals for two persons. A limited number of cabins at the school are made available during the summer. 2016 dates are June 10 – August 17.

Arrangements can be made by the buyer to extend the package for additional days. The buyer needs to contact the Education Department (877-877-3265) to confirm availability of the days and to place a reservation.

The clean, comfortable cabins with private shower are adjacent to Granite Creek which provides ample habitat for cut throat trout.

In addition to fishing opportunities in Granite Creek, a few miles downstream is the Hoback River which joins the Snake River at Hoback Junction. There is fantastic hiking to some of the states pristine alpine lakes or just spend a relaxing half hour or so soaking in the Granite Hot Springs, 2 miles north of the AWLS school.

Surrounded by the beauty of the Gros Ventre Wilderness area within Bridger-Teton National Forest, the AWLS site at 7,000 feet elevation is only 33 miles southeast of Jackson, Wyoming. Jackson, rich in frontier history still enjoys a western home town flavor with bi-weekly rodeos, numerous wildlife art galleries, fine restaurants, trail rides and both scenic and white water raft trips on the Snake River. The location is an ideal vacation hub for visiting either Teton or Yellowstone National Park.

Come hunt the 650,000 acre Loxodonta African Conservancy near Kamanjab, Namibia with Roger and Amelia Coomber. The conservancy is largely comprised of low fence cattle ranches rich with indigenous game. In addition to many common plains game animals, you may choose to hunt more unusual animals like the Hartmann's mountain zebra and Damara dik-dik in their native habitat. The terrain is big and open, broken with sand rivers and dolerite koppies. Namibia is the second least densely populated country in the world.

This safari is a seven day hunt for two hunters (2x1); plus one day of sight-seeing, two travel days, 9 nights; and includes all accommodations in modern guest rooms, laundry service, and wonderful food. This donation includes \$2,000 in trophy fees to be split between the hunters. Rifle or bow can be used. For the bowhunters, please note that Roger is a passionate bowhunter and the chairman of the bowhunting committee for the Namibia Professional Hunting Association. This hunt is for the 2016 or 2017 season. Hunt may be upgraded to 1x1 for an additional \$185 per camp night per hunter. Additional days or hunters may be added for \$350 2x1 or \$400 1x1 per camp night. Non-hunters may be added for \$200 per camp night.
