State Blood Drive Chairman:

"To support NH K of C efforts to double Council blood drives/collections over the next two years including new collection efforts with Councils that have not previously conducted a drive, Red Cross and K of C are offering Council level training sessions for DD, Council GK, Blood Drive Coordinators, and volunteers over the next several months. Times are by appointment only - minimum class size if 5 Council BDC. This is for Councils that are currently conducting drives and Councils considering to startup a new effort.

The first set of sessions are being offered before Lent on 30 January and 6 February 2016 (Saturday) at the Red Cross Manchester Blood Drive Center for 2 training sessions each day approx 3 hours a session - 10 AM and 2 PM.

Topics to include:

- Red Cross communication of collection site level policies and procedures including Double Red, Rapid Pass and Walk-in management posted placards at event if possible. Emphasis on pre-sign schedule execution with walk-in management.
- Site schedule (template) tailoring by BDS and ARC AM to accommodate walk-in vs pre-sign history, Double Red, Rapid Pass as well as TR support (as appropriate).
- BDC use of RC website for pre-sign including email and scheduling.
- BDC use of RC website for day of event for donor email/phone data corrections, facilitate Rapid Pass registration, POS forward scheduling (schedule donor for next event 2-4 months days in future).
- Availability of Red Cross develop "just in time" training for new volunteers including use of experienced volunteers for KoC drives with emphasis on new parish startup training and web training emphasis Low volume (1/year), New BDC or startup operations (never done before)
- Marketing and signage leveraging social media
- Cross District Scheduling and promotion
- Special programs youth drives etc




