#### YOUTH MINISTRY

One Bread, One Cup Liturgical Conference Reflections

Thank you so much for all of your prayers as several of our youth were attending the One Bread, One Cup Liturgical Youth Conference. It was a wonderful and blessed experience! One Bread, One Cup is aimed for those going into the 10th-12th grade. If you would be interested in further information about next year's retreat, contact Tom Malewitz at the parish office.

Andrea Anthony was in the focus group: Cantor Development. In her group, Andrea focused on leading the hymns at Mass and prayer services. Her instructor was Janet Whitaker Sullivan, a composer and music director from the Diocese of Oakland. Many of Janet's hymns can be found in the Spirit & Song books.

"'No.' This was what went through my head every time my parents or Tom had mentioned this retreat, since they signed me up in February. 'I don't want to go. Week long retreats are not my thing.' I mean, I love Youth 2000 retreats, but that's just one weekend, and I stay with my group the whole time. One Bread, One Cup was five days, with most of my time spent with my theological reflection group. This did not sound like fun. But on July 6th I found myself at St. Meinrad's with 150 teens from across the US. I now regret that I spent the first night waiting for the sessions to be over so I could go to my room and call home. Because even in the first couple of hours I learned so much. By lunch the second day I was enjoying myself immensely, and at the end of day 5, I even cried while saying goodbye to my new friends and getting ready to leave St. Meinrad.

To say the least, OBOC was an amazing experience, to be honest, it was life-changing. The first day we received the Short Christian Prayer books, and prayed the Liturgy of the Hours all week. The monks gave talks everyday discussing the OBOC theme - Word, Sacrament, Mission. The theology was in-depth and mature, to help us understand more deeply the things we we've been taught our whole life.

I learned much more than I expected to in my cantor group. We cantored all the Masses through the week. Our instructor wrote most of the music we sang, and has many songs published in the Spirit & Song books, so the experience with her was amazing. I feel that I better understand the role of a cantor, and the responsibilities that go with it.

The week was also a time of spiritual growth. We had Mass everyday, prayers several times a day, and an amazing reconciliation service. The week was altogether a wonderful experience. The only thing that could've made it better would be to have a larger parish/high school group. Hopefully next year more teens will go on this retreat. Even if it doesn't sound like something you would like, I can say from experience, that you will end up loving it." - Andrea Anthony, St. Romuald Parish
