ATTENTION ALL HANDLERS: NEW JUMP HEIGHT CARD RULE

Effective January 1,2001: For dogs two years and older: Owner/Handler must present a permanent height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing or provide the Trial Secretary with a photo copy of the official Jump Height Card with entry form. For dogs under two years of age: Owner/Handler must present a temporary height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing. A Judge of record for that trial, or a measuring official, if present, shall do the measuring of dogs.

Novice B: For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

Open: For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the

Excellent title.

Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

Height Divisions

The following height divisions shall be used in all Regular classes:

Preferred Classes

Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must only be entered in Preferred Classes or Regular Classes with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials.

Novice: All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time **must** enter the Novice level regardless of their previous title. Novice is NOT divided into A and B divisions.

Open: For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. Only handlers entered in a class are allowed to walk the course during familiarization. No coaches/instructors are allowed unless they are entered in the class. No obstacle familiarization will be offered at this event. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than noon on the Monday preceding the event.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 12 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breeds and breeds not recognized by the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Dogs may wear only flat, buckle collars without any tags or attachments. Dogs may run without collars. No food, toys or other training aids will be permitted in the course area
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog
 in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- Full refund for bitches in season before the Monday preceding the event. 50% refund for bitches in season between Tuesday and Friday.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE EINTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Exhibitors, while competing must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
