If you have a question about whether some conduct or proposed conduct would violate the Code of Ethics, you may ask for a Request for Advisory Opinion from the Ethics Commission. Like the Code itself, a Request for Advisory Opinion is a tool for you to use in making ethical choices.

Please describe the facts of the action or proposed action that you believe may or may not constitute a violation of the Boise Code of Ethics in sufficient detail so that the Ethics Commission can understand and issue an opinion. Give as much detail as possible, including approximate dates, names, etc.
