The minimum hour requirement for a Presidential Volunteer Service Award and United Way's competitive awards are: over a 12 month period - For individual nominees: youth ages 14 and under, 50 hours, everyone age 15 and above, 100 hours. For groups, the total must be 250

hours with each recognized member contributing at least 50 hours towards the total. Students who earned a Presidential Volunteer Service award will receive the award at their school awards banquet or from the school counseling office. Adult recipients and top youth winners will be invited to the United Way Annual Meeting & Volunteer Awards (date, time, and location TBA). 
