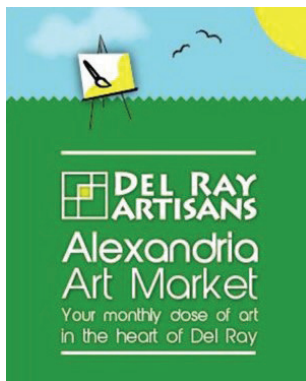

Widely published, she has worked with first-tier American museums, influential historic designers, and with notable living fashion and textile designers. August 3 - October 26, 2014

DELRAY ARTISANS & the ANIMAL WELFARE LEAGUE OF ALEXANDRIA present a fundraising exhibition of animal-themed art at the Vola Lawson Animal Shelter.

Artists are invited to submit 2D artworks with the subject matter of animals and art with animal-related themes. Artists may submit animal-themed art that was shown at Del Ray Artisans (DRA) previously. Artworks will be displayed on the walls at the Animal Welfare League of Alexandria (AWLA)'s Vola Lawson Animal Shelter for three months. As this is a fundraising effort by both organizations, we are requesting a 40% donation if your works sells, which will be split between DRA and AWLA. In addition, we are charging an entry fee to help defray costs of mounting this exhibition. Art must be submitted digitally for this exhibit. See instructions on entry form.

Del Ray Artisans is also accepting used blankets and towels to donate to the shelter during this exhibition. These items may be dropped off at DRA's gallery or at the animal shelter.

- **DEADLINE IS July 18** (Notification of acceptance by July 25)
- Accepted artwork must be dropped off at the Vola Lawson Animal Shelter at 4101 Eisenhower Ave, Alexandria VA 22304 on **Sunday, August 3 between 1pm–4pm.**
- Artists may submit up to {3} pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for accepted artwork.
- Artists must pay their entry fees when dropping off their accepted artwork at the shelter, or prior to drop-off at Del Ray Artisans. Cash and checks accepted at drop-off; credit card payments must be made at in advance at Del Ray Artisans gallery or at: squareup.com/market/del-ray-artisans/awla
- Final acceptance for this exhibit is at the curators' discretion upon viewing artwork at drop-off.
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for details.
- When your art sells, you are asked to make a 40% donation (tax deductible) which is evenly split between DRA and AWLA.

Accepted Artist Requirements (fine print):

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements.
- **All artists MUST volunteer** with set-up, hanging or take down. (No gallery hosting hours are required for this off-site exhibit)
- Insurance for artwork is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans, Animal Welfare League of Alexandria, nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions of your original artwork)
- Any artwork left over 30 days after the close of the show will become property of Del Ray Artisans.
- Print out and keep a copy of both sides of this form for your records.
