- Be a currently enrolled Columbus State University student at the time the grant is requested
- Have attended CSU and taken classes for at least one full semester prior to the study abroad program's term
- Be in good academic standing (minimum 2.0 GPA or above)

Note: Students are only eligible for one award per academic year.

Submission Requirements

- The application must be submitted during the correct submission period in order to be considered. Contact CIE if you are unsure of the correct dates applicable to your program.
- A valid photo ID (i.e. CSU ID or driver's license) must be presented by the student submitting the Grant Request Form.
- No applications can be submitted on behalf of another student. No applications will be accepted from individuals other than the applicant whose name is on the form.
