**Final Payment** Registration balances (if any) must be paid at least **2 WEEKS BEFORE** the start date of your registered camp program. You may make your final payment by choosing one of the following options:

- Online If you registered online payments may be made by logging into your account from the Camp website, <u>www.lutherhaven.org</u>.

- Mail your payment along with a copy of your confirmation e-mail.

**Before Registration** Join us for an outdoor worship service at 11:00 am in the Pavilion on Sunday morning. Families can bring a picnic lunch or join us in the Dining Room for Sunday lunch (ages 13+: \$6/person, children ages 6-12: \$4./person, children 5 & under are free). You can enjoy the afternoon until the Camp program begins at 2:45 pm by hiking around camp, swimming, or boating.

**Registration** will take place in the DANIEL RETREAT CENTER from 1:00-2:30pm, Sunday afternoon, June 29<sup>th</sup>. At 2:45pm, everyone is encouraged to attend an Opening Celebration in the Pavilion until approximately 3:15 p.m. The Servant Event will begin following the Opening Celebration. <u>Friday, you will spend the morning with a closing worship, followed by a trip to Pine Lake</u> Water Park in the afternoon and will end at 5:00 pm. (Lutherhaven is on EDT)

- In order to make registration a speedy, pleasant process, we are asking you to:
- Have your balance paid 2 weeks prior.
- Complete registration between 1:00 and 2:30 pm. If you are unable to be at Camp during this time, please notify the office beforehand to make special arrangements.
- Have your medical information/parent permission form completed. If you have any medications, please bring them to registration to leave with the First Aid Coordinator. (See Medical Information below for details.)
- Come to registration process to go through a brief medical screening.

**MEDICAL INFORMATION/PARENT PERMISSION FORM** In this packet, you received the Medical Information/Parent Permission Form that is to be presented at the time of registration. If needed, you may also download the form from our website. <u>Please read through</u> <u>carefully and get all signatures.</u> Camp Lutherhaven reserves the right to refuse/delay registration for ill or injured campers and send home campers who become ill or injured while at Camp. (NOTE! *All over-the-counter and prescription medicines MUST be turned in at registration except for inhalers and topical creams as prescribed by your physician for self-administration. Label all medication with the child's name and any special instructions. Prescribed medication must be in its original container and state the camper's name and doctor's instructions. If you have a food intolerance or food allergy, please contact Camp at least two weeks prior to arrival.)* 

**CAMPER SPENDING** opportunities will be available throughout the week. The Camp T-shirt Store will be open Sunday and Friday during registration and closing. During the week, camp utilizes camper banks, a cashless credit system which Servant Eventers can use to purchase snack items. If desired, money can be deposited into this account during registration. You are also welcome to bring your own snacks to share with the group. At the end of the week you may pick up the balance of the camper bank money or choose to donate it to **Hope International.** This organization shares the hope of Christ by empowering communities with financial education that is Biblically based. Hope International enables individuals to achieve self-sustaining incomes so that they can permanently break the cycle of poverty in their communities. Hope International works in 17 countries around the world including: Haiti, Rwanda, and India. For more information go to www.hopeinternational.org.

FREE PICTURE Every servant eventer will receive free a group photo of the campers and staff in their session.

**MEMORY DVD'S** are available for preordering. These DVD's will have videos and pictures from your child's time at camp and will include all of the participants of your child's program. The DVDs are sold for \$6 and will be distributed to campers on the last day of camp. If you have not already paid for this optional purchase with your initial registration, you may include it during your Sunday's registration check-in.

**SPECIAL REQUESTS** We understand that at times, you may be involved in sports games/practices and other activities at home. If you must attend one of these activities while at Camp, please bring a written notice to registration stating the day(s), times and who will be picking up/dropping you off. Also, if you must arrive at Camp late or leave early, please notify the office in advance. <u>Always check in at the office first when any of these pick-ups and/or drop-offs are necessary.</u>

**ABOUT THE NOBLE SERVANTS SERVANT EVENT** We are thankful for your participation in this summer's service event! You will help to re-construct Lutherhaven's dock & floating pier on Petty Pond. This project will give future participants a first-hand experience of the teeming life in this part of Camp that includes frogs, turtles, beavers, fish, dragon flies and yes, even snakes (although non-poisonous). Please contact the camp office if you have any questions as you plan your venture to Camp Lutherhaven for a week of servanthood. An additional mailing will be sent out in early May with some more details about the week, including a tentative schedule.

**REFUNDS** Your \$50 deposit is non-refundable except for instances of illness or injury to you or a death in your family.

**LOST & FOUND** Every year we accumulate hundreds of lost and found items. Please consider labeling all important articles (Bibles, cameras, towels, sleeping bags) that you are bringing to Camp. After camp, contact us if you are missing something.

**PHONE** In keeping with Camp Lutherhaven's community policy <u>cell phones may not remain with Servant Eventers</u>. However, we also recognize that there may be a special circumstance where a phone call is the best option for communication. Please call the Camp office or speak with a staff member at registration to discuss arrangements. We ask that all group leaders maintain possession of their group's phones. Individual Servant Eventers will be asked to turn in their cell phones at registration.


