

MOWR Program at Georgia State University Perimeter College:

- 1) Meet with your high school counselor regarding your plans. Complete the "Move On When Ready Student Participation Agreement" with your parents and high school counselor.
- 2) Review eligibility below:
 - a) Must be a high school junior or senior.
 - b) Must have a 3.0 unweighted core GPA as calculated by GSU Perimeter College.
 - c) Must have either eligible SAT or ACT scores:

- 3) Apply to GSU Perimeter College following these steps:
 - a) Use the application fee waiver "CAMPUSWAIVER"
 - b) Goto www.GAcollege411.org
 - c) Follow the prompts to complete the college application.
- 4) Deadlines for application:
 - a) Fall Semester July 1st
 - b) Spring Semester November 1st
 - c) Summer Semester April 1st
 - d) Please note that some high schools impose different application deadlines.
- 5) Submit required documents to the Enrollment and Registration Office at one of the GSU Perimeter College locations.
 - a) Official High School Transcript
 - b) Official SAT or ACT Scores
 - c) Immunization Records (http://depts.gpc.edu/immunizations/immunizationcertificate.pdf)
 - d) Parental Consent Form
 - e) Verification of Lawful Presence (Driver's License, U.S. Passport, Birth Certificate)
 - f) MOWR Student Participation Agreement (http://www.gadoe.org/Curriculum-Instruction-and-Assessment/CTAE/Documents/MOWR-Student-Participation-Agreement-public.pdf)
- 6) If admitted, you will receive an acceptance letter from the GSU Perimeter College Admissions Office. You may monitor your admissions status at: https://eapps.gpc.edu/mystatus
- 7) Your MOWR Coordinator will offer academic guidance, including, math placement, and will review the Move On When Ready Funding Option. Contact us for an appointment once you have been admitted to the program at GSU Perimeter College. Orientation will be addressed at the appointment.
