N early 99 percent of Pennsylvania's 7,200 dairy farms are family owned and operated. With the average age of these farm owners now approaching 58 years old, many have already or will soon need to develop a blue print for transitioning the ownership and management of that farm to the next generation. Are you beginning to walk down the path to transitioning your farm to the next generation? Then plan to attend this workshop.

Designed to have the facilitator and the family work together throughout the program, the workshop will better equip any dairy farm family to walk through the complex steps of transferring the ownership and management of a dairy business to the next generation. It will look at the eight critical areas of any family business transition and help participants identify how those eight areas affect their individual dairy operations. Participants will leave with a blueprint to move through a successful dairy farm transition and a better sense of how to address the issues that will arise as they move through that blueprint.


