It is possible to enroll in more than one club. If your child attends After Care on a regular basis it is recommended that they are involved in at least 2 clubs. Please ensure that **all preferences** are indicated on the Club Preference Form.

Every effort will be made to meet the first preference that has been noted but this cannot be guaranteed. Children who consistently do not attend their club will forfeit their position. **In the case of a club not running** due to the absence of a club instructor or inclement weather, children will go to After Care free of charge (as long as they are picked up at the time the club would normally finish.)

Most Clubs will run from **3:30 to 4:30 pm**. Please check times and venues carefully. **All students must go to After Care to wait to be sent to Clubs.** (3:00-3:30pm is free for Club participants.) Any child not collected at the end of clubs will be taken to After Care. There will be a few minutes "grace period" before any After Care charges are applied.
