## Course Description:

This three (3) day seminar is designed to prepare Candidates to take the SR/WA Comprehensive Examination by reviewing the seven (7) core disciplines of the right of way profession. It is intended to allow participants to brush up on areas in which they may have limited experience or knowledge. The Comprehensive Exam (United States version) will be administered at the conclusion of the review session, in the afternoon of the third day, and covers the seven (7) core disciplines: Engineering, Law, Negotiation, Valuation, Environment, Relocation, and Asset Management.

Tuition Refund Policy: Written notification of intent to cancel registration must be received via email by both the Course Coordinator and IRWA Headquarters Education Staff (education@inwaonline.org) prior to the class start date in order to be eligible for a tuition refund. A full tuition refund will be issued if notice is received 15 days or more prior to the class start date; a 75% refund will be issued if notice is received less than 15 days prior to the class start date, and no refund will be issued for notice received on or after the class start date.
