I am pleased to announce the opening of registration for Hayes Barton Baptist Preschool's Annual Summer Day Camp Program! Please read the descriptions and dates of each session. Fill out and return the attached registration form indicating the session(s) for which you'd like to enroll.

The fee is \$125 per session. Payment is due in full at registration. There will be no refunds given after May 1, 2016.

The program is open to rising two-year-olds (2 on or before August 31, 2016) through six-year-olds. Enrollment will be on a first come-first served basis within the following four priority groups:

- Through March 17—Current and incoming HBBP families
- March 18 - March 24—Church members not currently enrolled
- March 25 - March 31—Former campers
- March 31 - until full—General Public

Important instructions for all sessions of camp:

1. Camp doors open at 9:30am. If you arrive early, please enjoy the playground.
2. A mid-morning snack will be provided each day.
3. Each child will bring their own lunch (including drink) daily.
4. Dress your child in comfortable clothes. PLEASE WEAR TENNIS SHOES FOR SAFETY AND GYMNASIUM USE.
5. A list of items needed, if applicable, may be sent to you via email prior to the first day of camp.
