2 Venue and Date

2.1 The Championship will be held from Tuesday 19th to Sunday 24th July 2011 in Thoune.

3 Rules

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 3.2 The "Regulations for Swiss Championships" of Swiss Sailing will apply.
- 3.3 Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply.
- 3.4 The Star Class Rules will apply.
- 3.4 Sailing Instruction of the Star Class Swiss Championship 2011.
- 3.5 In case of a conflict between languages the German text will prevail.

4 Eligibility

- 4.1 The regatta is open to boats from other countries than Switzerland.
- 4.2 Competitors must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.
- 4.3 The person in charge of a boat shall be a member of the Star Class Association.

5 Advertising

- 5.1 Advertising will be permitted in accordance with class rules, ISAF Advertising Code Regulation 20 and Swiss Sailing Regulations of Advertising.
- 5.2 Advertising of the Main Sponsor of the Event on the boats is possible (ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20.4)

6 Entry

6.1 Entries shall be submitted using the official Entry Form, completely filled out.

The following documents shall be enclosed to the Entry Form:

- Measurement Certificate with Weight Certificate.
- Proof of club membership or license.
- Proof of third-party liability insurance 2011.
- Proof of approval for advertising.

7.2 Scheduled Races:

- The Championship will be sailed with a maximum of 6 valid races.
- To constitute the Championship, at least 4 valid races shall be sailed during the scheduled time.
- At any day no more than 3 valid races will be sailed, except that at only one day 4 valid races can be sailed.
- If 4 or more valid races are sailed until Saturday evening, 1 race only is scheduled on Sunday.

8 <u>Measurement</u>

- 8.1 The check of the Measurement Certificates and measurements will take place in the tent next to the Clubhouse.
- 8.2 No first measurements will be carried out.

9 Scoring

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A RRS will apply.
- 9.2 If 4 or more valid races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 Prizes

- 10.1 The following prizes will be awarded:
 - Championship Medals for the first 3 boats
 - Prizes for the first 10 boats
 - Souvenirs for each competitor

11 Mooring and Parking

- 11.1 For every boat a suitable place will be provided by the harbor master or the organizer. Arrangements of the harbor master or the organizers shall be biding.
- 11.2 Parking permits will be distributed during registration. Cars and trailers of participants will only parked at assigned areas. Arrangements of the organizers will be binding.
- 11.3 Parking of caravans or mobile homes at the club parking area is not allowed.

12 Support boats

- 12.1 Support boats shall be registered at the Race Office before the beginning of the event.

 Authorization for the navigation on the waters must be obtained from the participants themselves.

 A valid third-party liability insurance shall be produced at request.
- 12.2 Support boats will be part of the security arrangements for the event.

14.1. Competitors are reminded of rule 5 and ISAF Regulation 21 Anti Doping Rule and Anti Doping Code, which ban the use of drugs. Drugs testing may take place during the event in accordance with rules of "Antidoping Switzerland / Swiss Olympic"

15 **Liability and Insurance**

- 15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (RRS rule 4 Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
- 15.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event (min. 1,5 Mio CHF or min. 1,0 Mio Euro) and valid for racing.
