

Draw and Helper's Roster:

Please provide helpers name and phone number via this e-mail <u>ritterfamily@ymail.com</u>, or confirm on the day when purchasing your tickets. IQ Riders must supply the name of a helper.

<u>Please remember these days are run by volunteers and cannot run without people to work as gate stewards, pencillers, rail stewards, etc.</u>

Competitor's Responsibility:

Competitors are responsible for checking with the DPI regarding the requirement for spraying of horses.

Canteen facilities will be available all weekend.

A first aid officer will be available all weekend.

A Vet will be on call but the owner/rider of the horse will be obliged to pay for the service.

A Farrier will be on all but the owner/rider of the horse will be obliged to pay for the service.

- CEGI reserves the right to refuse any nomination as they deem appropriate;
- Riders competiting in classes 1.05m and above must be an Equestrian Australia member and must present current membership card at time of nomination;
- Riders competiting in all other classes must be a CEGI member (day membership is available), excluding IQ riders;
- Dogs are welcome on the grounds but MUST not be in the Ring/Warm Up areas at any times. Dogs
 must be kept on a leash at all times, loose dogs will be impounded at the owners expense;
- A completed Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration must be handed in by no later than the first day of competition;
- Horse and Rider combinations may start in more than one Championship per day;
- Manure and Hay must be picked up and placed in designated Manure areas;
- All rubbish must be placed in bins provided.

Nominations:

Nominations can be made through www.nominate.com.au prior to event, or made at the nominations desk on the day of competition.

IQ Interschool State Championship qualifying rounds – in order for interschool qualifiers to be recognised by IQ, nominations must be made through www.nominate.com.au. Please note as per IQ rules, riders must have their IQ number attached to both sides of their saddle cloth.

Stables/Yards/Camping:

Stables/yards/camping are available and must be booked by completing the attached form and sending an e-mail to ritterfamily@ymail.com.

Stables/Yards are \$40 p/stable/yard for the duration of event. Stables/yards required outside this period are to booked and paid direct to YHPC – contact Paula Barlow 0409 340 206.

Camping is \$50 per float/truck/tent for the duration of the event, camping required outside of this period is to be booked and paid direct to YHPC – contact Paula Barlow 0409 340 206.

YHPC Stable bond:

\$25 p/stable/yard is required by the Yeppoon Hack & Pony Club, this bond will be refunded back to the competitor upon inspection of the stables/yards by a CEGI and YHPC representative, please ensure when paying this bond you provide your bank account details, as these refunds will be paid back to your nominated bank account.

Power:

Note all power cords/extension cords must be 15 amp and be appropriately tested/tagged. Any altered 15 amp leads (earth filed down or modified) to suit a 10 amp power socket **are not permitted** to be used on YHPC grounds. Any power outlets damaged due to overloading (eg piggy backing off other leads), will be charged to the applicable camp site at the replacement fee of \$120 p/outlet.

Routine inspections will be conducted to prevent damage to the power outlets and extension cords will be removed and confiscated if required.

YHPC Ground Fees:

\$10 p/horse for the duration of the event (this fee is applicable to all day users as well).

Please note all fees (stabling/camping/ground) must be finalised prior to competiting.

An armband will be supplied upon receipt of payments, gate stewards will be unable to allow competitors in the ring if they are not wearing this armband.

Dress Standard:

Dress: Shirt and tie or ratcatcher be worn in both rings. Jackets are required for all Championship Classes.

Entertainment:

Friday night 25 March free nibblies will be supplied by the CEGI Jump Club for those of you that will be staying with us Friday evening. Venue and time will be advised to those on the grounds on Friday.

If we have enough interested folks in attendance we will order in pizza and drinks will be available for a Gold Coin Donation.

Saturday night 26 March meals will be available from the Country Music Club, the club is fully licensed and is situated directly behind the YHPC Grounds on Millroy Drive.
