IREM[®] Side-Line... "Anyone Could be a Carrier"

This is how we solve disputes Texas-style.

Are we reverting back 100 years to the "ole west"?

The dirt sidewalks are long gone, and parking lots have replaced corrals; Hip Hop, Rap and Britney Spears have replaced the lone piano player; large TV screens, the poker game, and the glove box in our car replaced the gun sheath on the horse.

There were a lot more places to hide a gun back then, especially given the amount of clothing that people wore. I can't see a 9 millimeter fitting snug in the top of my panty hose or tucked under a mini skirt, but 100 years ago, the old Smith and Wesson six gun was secured in an open holster with plenty of bullets conveniently at arms reach, screaming to the world "don't mess with me".

With all the murders and assaults going on these days, should we consider taking a step back? Do we have the right to protect ourselves, or are we opening ourselves up to more violence? So, I'm driving home from work in the heat of traffic, and this F150 pick-up passes by in a big hurry, cuts off the guy next to him; he gets mad and pulls out his gun in a rage and.. bang; not a picture that makes me feel secure on the road. Or another warming thought... Prozac (antidepressants) and guns... now there's a good mix.

Does Columbine ring a bell? The heart wrenching event at Virginia Tech recently is a somber awakening of how easy it is to obtain legal firearms. Cho Seung-Hui is reported to have been known to be mentally unstable and taking antidepressants. He had no criminal history and was a permanent legal resident with a green card. He followed the law and underwent the required background checks.

According to MSN: Contrary to initial reports, Cho may not have been legally eligible to acquire the two semi-automatic weapons. Critics say Cho was able to collect his firearms without a hitch because of a gaping hole in the enforcement of existing federal gun laws that routinely allows mentally unstable people to buy deadly firearms.

In the three months before the shooting, Cho bought two handguns: a Walther .22 that he picked up on February 9 at a Blacksburg pawn shop, and a second, more powerful, Glock 9mm, purchased on March 16 at a firearms store. Cho filled out the required federal form, and a federally-mandated background check was conducted by the Virginia state police, but he was immediately cleared to buy the guns when no "hits" showed up in the police database indicating that he had any history of criminal activity. (quoted: MSN.com, "Did Cho Buy the Guns Legally?")

Now, let's turn our thoughts to what happens when tenants start toting guns while property managers are working hard to find ways to secure the property and the area around the property to make a safe work environment. I'm all about rights. It seems ironic however, that we may be coming full circle after a hundred years.

If bill SB 534 passes, it will require all businesses to allow anyone to bring loaded guns, including deadly assault weapons, onto their privately-owned business property, and also threatens to punish business leaders should they choose to keep their workplaces safe by prohibiting guns. It allows legal recourse by the employee for any disciplinary actions on behalf of the employer.

California, Utah, Missouri, Indiana, Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia, Florida, Virginia and New Hampshire all have proposed legislation that would permit guns in the workplace. Did you know that Oklahoma already has a similar legislation in effect? This legislation was passed in May 2005. The legislation prohibits, and furthermore makes it a crime for anyone (including a business) to bar any person, except a convicted felon, from bringing a gun to the workplace as long as it is kept in a locked vehicle. The list of properties where individuals can bring a gun include all businesses, schools and libraries, day care centers, chemical plants, nuclear facilities, courts and prisons. Oklahoma's forced-entry statute permits individuals to sue persons, property owners, tenants, employers or businesses to force them to accept guns on their property.

There are many concerns that surround this legislation. For example, employer's loss of control to protect their employees by enforcing policies resulting in less safety for employees in the workplace. It also opens up the potential for employee violence with more lethal results, not to mention the liability exposure to employers.

How then would this affect OSHA's existing policies of hazard prevention in the workplace? The Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1970 includes a "general duty clause" that requires each employer to "furnish to each of his employees... a place of employment which [is] free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to his employees".

On the other hand, do we have a constitutional right to preventative measures concerning crime? Would a thief or mugger run if they see you pull out a gun? Would it discourage crime if more people were able to stand up for themselves against alleged attackers? With terrorism lurking around every corner, do we need to have some means of immediate protection?
