

The Great Second Chance John 20

Disappointment robs us of hope and passion (v. 30 & 31)

- 1. Mary Magdalene was emotionally pained with *grief* (v. 11-13)
 - a. Emotions are powerful, don't stuff them
 - b. BUT don't let them control you
 - c. Don't hold on (to me) BUT go and tell (v. 16-18)
- 2. The disciples were paralyzed by *fear* (v. 19a)
 - a. Fear for our country
 - b. Fear leads to retreat so that you can't move
 - c. Jesus restored their hope and gave purpose to them (v. 19b 21)
- 3. Thomas was perplexed with **skepticism** (v. 24 29)
 - a. Don't reject the testimony of others
 - b. The devil gives 1000's of reasons to be skeptical
 - c. Why not pray, "Show me the way"
