A train-the-trainer Advanced Master Gardener Class will be offered free of charge to all Certified Master Gardeners. To qualify for the two credits this class offers, you will be required to perform an outreach project in your community. Educational materials will be provided to trainers. The UConn Master Gardener Program is assisting the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station and the USDA in educating all CT residents on how to identify the ALB and how not to potentially and unintentionally move it into our communities. Help us get the word out!

Connecticut's forests and urban trees are under threat from another exotic beetle as well. The Emerald Ash Borer is approaching Connecticut from Central Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New York State where it has killed millions of ash trees.

This seminar will cover identification, the biology and behaviors of these two beetles. Participants will learn the host trees for each. Weather permitting we will have an outdoor exercise to find host trees and some pinned ALBs hidden in the trees.

We will also cover the process of reporting sightings of either beetle to the proper authorities, as they are USDA regulated pests.
