All exhibitors must be a current member of the American Stock Horse Association to compete. All horses must have an ASHA competition license to compete. Competition License can be obtained at the show, by providing a copy of the current registration papers or a copy of coggins (if not registered) with the appropriate application. A copy of both membership and competition license **MUST** be included with entry forms.

All Horses must have a current negative Coggins test (within the last 12 months) and out of state horses must have a health certificate within the last 30 days.

Entries Due: February 21, 2013 – Late entries accepted up **until 7:00am** the day of the show with a \$20 late fee and no guarantee of fresh cattle. Cancellations and/or no shows will be financially responsible for the office fee and the cattle fee (if you were entered in the working cow class).
