. Why You Shouldn't Be Listening Right Now

a. Keep Away From This:

- i. There are a lot of reasons Satan wants to keep you away from (tonight's message)... (pg.5)
- b. But, More Importantly:
 - i. There is one reason why Jesus... (pg.5)
- c. Purity Self-Portrait
 - i. Kerstin's story (pg.7 = pic on screen)

Matthew 5:8 = "God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God." (NLT)

II. Your Invitation To Pure Joy

a. A Flood Of Questions

- i. "Hearts pure"? = Provoke flood of questions... (pg.8)
- ii. This study was created to help you reach the understanding that purity **is** an attainable goal in the life of a follower of Christ. (pg.8)

Luke 10:40-41 = "⁴⁰But Martha was distracted with all her preparations; and she came up to Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to do all the serving alone? Then tell her to help me."

⁴¹But the Lord answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and bothered about so many things." (NASB)

- What does this story teach us about our focus? (pg.8, Students share)
- iv. Are you more like Martha, running around trying to do a lot of things; or are you more like her sister Mary, sitting at Jesus' feet, listening to what He has to say? (pg.8)
- b. Can You Relate To This Guy?

i. Dave's story (pg.8-9 = pic on screen)

2 Samuel 11:1-5 = "¹Then it happened in the spring, at the time when kings go out to battle, that David sent Joab and his servants with him and all Israel, and they destroyed the sons of Ammon and besieged Rabbah. But David stayed at Jerusalem. ²Now when evening came David arose from his bed and walked around on the roof of the king's house, and from the roof he saw a woman bathing; and the woman was very beautiful in appearance. ³So David sent and inquired about the woman. And one said, "Is this not Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?" ⁴David sent messengers and took her, and when she came to him, he lay with her; and when she had purified herself from her uncleanness, she returned to her house. ⁵The woman conceived; and she sent and told David, and said, "I am pregnant."" (NASB)



- ii. How does Dave's story relate to King David's struggle? (pg.9)
- iii. King David experienced restlessness and emptiness similar to Dave's. This lack of peace ultimately drove him to commit unspeakable sins that put up a wall between him and God. The concept of purity is more than just a sexual barometer. Purity is a vital part of every aspect of your life, but it is not something that you can attain on your own... allow Him complete and total access to every public and private area of your life." (pg.9)
- c. When You Can't Do It Alone
 - i. 2 Corinthians 12:9 = His grace is sufficient!
- d. You Know You Need His Help
 - i. If you know you need His help, how much time do you spend with him?
 - ii. "Where Am I?" questions (pg.10)
 - iii. Colossians 3:17 = whatever you do, do it for Him!
 - iv. Think about this = "I find it difficult to give God complete access to these things in my life..." (pg.10)

III. Your Question Of Where You've Been

a. Most difficult thing = forgive themselves for sin of the past.

- **b.** Questions To Think About (pg.11):
 - i. What events or things in your past have made you hesitant to even try to be pure before God?
 - ii. Are there any areas or issues of unforgiveness in your life that have driven a wedge b/t you and God?
 - iii. What idols are present in your life?
- c. Idols are things that you consider to be more important than or equally important as your relationship with God.
- d. There's Hope! (The good news is that God has the ability to completely bring you into purity!)
 - i. 1 John 1:9, Isa, 1:18, Col. 3:13, Ps, 103:12 (pg, 12)

Your Happiness And Your Joy (The Difference) IV.

- a. We hear our friends say things like, "I'm just not happy with my life"... The root of the word *happy* is the same root that is used for *happens*. Happiness happens..., out of our control... happiness alone will never equal joy...
- b. Joy is an eternal satisfaction regardless of circumstance. Joy survives regardless of tragedy, defeat, or isolation. Joy is a God thing... In a dank, putrid, Roman jail, we find the apostle Paul penning the words, "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!" (Phil. 4:4)

Habakkuk 3:17-18 = "17-18Though the cherry trees don't blossom and the strawberries don't ripen. Though the apples are worm-eaten and the wheat fields stunted, Though the sheep pens are sheepless and the cattle barns empty, I'm singing joyful praise to God. I'm turning cartwheels of joy to my Savior God." (Message)

- i. You ever feel like that? (v.17)
- ii. Do you still praise God? (v.18)
- c. When these things happen, will you still be able to "rejoice in the Lord"? (1 Pet. 1:8) (pg.13)
